

Data Collection – Street Scene

- Description of Street Scene:

Included in this part of the survey, is a short stretch of Church Street and includes CS1 and 2, Hop Kiln Cottages.

Emerging from Village Street into Church Street, opposite is a small building on the side of the road, opposite The Old Bakery, which was once the Village Smithy, and now used as a store. Behind it are two semidetached cottages, probably 1930s, former Council Houses following on the building line from the Council Houses in Stratford Road.

Across the road is a small development of modern (probably 1980s) houses in Walnut Close.

Up the hill past the black and white cottage, (not included in this part of the survey) is a turning to the right, leading to a converted Oast House which was in the garden of James Cottage (on Church Street). Hop Kiln Cottages have been converted carefully to provide two dwellings.
