

## **Data Collection – Street Scene**

- Description of Street Scene:

Finch Lane is on the RHS of Village Street as the road follows the corner round from Dalkeith. The lane runs between the walls surrounding the gardens of the Old Rectory and The Retreat, both built of local stone. It then turns sharp right by the back entrance to Malthouse Close, from where there is a view through towards the church spire.

The lane passes a 1980s small development of larger houses on the LHS, and on the RHS 4 individual larger houses with a turning circle, and a narrow walkway between two of the houses through to the footpath behind the building line, and lookout point V.08.

The lane then bears left and on the RHS are two old black and white cottages, possibly C16, FL1, Finch Hay, and FL2, Rose Cottage.
