

Data Collection – Street Scene

- Description of Street Scene:

Shakespeare Lane runs up the hill to the East of Stratford Road. On the RHS are the three houses pictured, The Limes, a 16th Century Black and White farmhouse, The Barns, a converted collection of agricultural barns into one dwelling, and the three Cottages (probably 19th C) towards the top of the hill which stand at right angles to the Lane. At the apex of the hill is The Old Shakespeare Inn, now a private dwelling house, probably 19th C. On the LHS of the Lane is the row of 1930s Council Houses, with large back gardens, forming a cohesive building line. It has not proved possible to obtain a photograph of the Council Houses as the gardens are now surrounded by trees.
