

Report for Parish Plan

A summary of surveys

Over the past ten years or so the Parish Council has sought the views of the residents on several occasions, through 2 Housing Surveys, 2 public consultations plus 3 other opinion gathering written surveys.

Responses to the earlier consultations were from very few residents in the village and are reported here merely as they reflect in similar proportions the opinions expressed in the later surveys which had far higher returns.

Housing

The first survey, conducted at the end of the 1990s, elicited a response from just 36 households, covering 85 residents which is under 5% of the population.

The survey undertaken in 2009 is still being analysed and, therefore, not yet published but some figures from that are included here as they are available to the Parish Council and are being used here in another way. The response to this survey came from 265 households, some 570 residents which is around 35% of the population.
